Your building was inspected on May 18, 2012 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date.

A re-inspection will be made on June 19, 2012 at 1:45 PM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Exterior Garage SPLC 34.09 (1) b, c, 34.32 (1) b, c Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint. Repaint garage door.
- 2. Interior Basement laundry room SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.33 (6) Repair and maintain the walls in an approved manner. Move outlet covers behind dryer in laundry room so they are flush with wall.

- 3. Interior first floor bedroom MSFC 605.6 Provide electrical cover plates to all outlets, switches and junction boxes where missing. Replace missing outlet cover in basement by the couch.
- 4. Interior first floor bedroom SPC 4715.2000, 2110 Provide an approved backflow preventer. This work may require a permit, call Regional Water Services at (651) 266-8989. Replace hand held shower head in first floor bathroom.
- 5. Interior first floor bedrooms MSFC1026.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more information. Windows in both first floor bedrooms measure 34 inches width by 17 inches height of openable space.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
