Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on April 18, 2018.

The building was found to be unsafe, unfit for human habitation, a public nuisance, a hazard to the public welfare or otherwise dangerous to human life. A Condemnation Placard has been posted on the building.

The following deficiency list must be completed or the building vacated by the re-inspection date.

A reinspection will be made on April 19, 2018 at 3:30 PM.

CONDEMNATION OF THE BUILDING REVOKES THE CERTIFICATE OF OCCUPANCY.

Failure to complete the corrections may result in a criminal citation. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. CHANGE IN USE IMMEDIATELY DISCONTINUE UNAPPROVED USE MSBC 1300.022 Subp. 3 The occupancy group or use division of this building has been changed from that previously approved. Discontinue the unapproved occupancy or use, or contact the Building Official at 651-266-8989 with your code analysis and to comply with requirements for approved occupancy.
 - -This building has been approved as a Business Occupancy only. It has not been approved for Residential use. Discontinue use for Residential occupancy immediately. The unapproved Residential units much be vacated. Call DSI at 651-266-8989, or submit plans for review for possible Change in Use.
- 2. THROUGHOUT THE BUILDING SPLC 34.23, MSFC 110.1 This occupancy is condemned as unfit for human habitation. This occupancy must not be used until reinspected and approved by this office.
 - -Sleeping areas do not have code compliant egress windows and illegally converted units lack required fire extinguishers. Additionally, it appears new installation of electrical, plumbing, and construction was done without permits/approval

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
