Dear Property Representative:

A re-inspection was made on your building on January 8, 2025, in response to a referral. You are hereby notified that the following deficiencies must be corrected immediately.

A reinspection will be made on or after May 13, 2025.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

1. Unit 2 - Kitchen - MSBC -Section 1300.0120 Part 1 - Permits Required. An owner or authorized agent who intends to construct, enlarge, alter, repair, move, demolish, or change the occupancy of a building or structure, or to erect, install, enlarge, alter, repair, remove, convert, or replace any gas, mechanical, electrical, plumbing system, or other equipment, the installation of which is regulated by the code; or cause any such work to be done, shall first make application to the building official and obtain the required permit.-
 - a. New stove has been installed and appears to be functioning properly
 - b. Installation of new stove requires work to be completed under permit, the work inspected, and the permit closed
 - c. UPDATE: Permit issued 01/10/2025
 - d. UPDATE: 04/10/2025 - Note that property has been sold, new owner shall contact the contractor to have the work on the stove inspected and the permit closed
