

RESOLUTION # 17-04

Authorizing the Department of Parks and Recreation to enter into a three-year lease agreement extension with the Highland District Council for office space at Highland Park Community Center.

WHEREAS, the Saint Paul Parks and Recreation Commission ("Commission") is an appointed body established to advise the Mayor and City Council on long-range and city-wide matters related to Parks and Recreation; and

WHEREAS, the Highland District Council wishes to enter into a three-year agreement extension with the City of Saint Department of Parks and Recreation for leased office space at Highland Park Community Center; and

WHEREAS, Saint Paul Administrative Code requires that any lease of parkland or recreation facilities which will be for a period of more than one year be approved by the City Council following a hearing before the Parks and Recreation Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Saint Paul Parks and Recreation Commission finds that the granting of a three year lease agreement at the Highland Park Community Center, 1978 Ford Parkway., has a public purpose and recommends approval of the lease;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Saint Paul Parks and Recreation Commission recommends that the City Council of the City of Saint Paul authorize the appropriate City officials to enter into the attached Lease Agreement

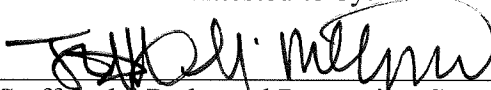
