This is to confirm that our office has received your applications for variances from the city's noise ordinance and that they are being processed. The above-referenced event will have amplified music/sound at the following locations: Cathedral Hill Park; Summit Avenue and Mississippi River Blvd; Mississippi River Blvd and the Old Ford Plant; Shepard Road and Gannon Road; Shepard Road between Homer Street and Elway Street; Shepard Road and Otto Avenue; Shepard Road and Randolph Avenue; Shepard Road under the Smith Avenue Bridge; Shepard Road between Washington Street and Eagle Street; Upper Landing Park; and Lower Landing Park. The Department of Safety and Inspections has recommended that variances be issued with conditions.

A public hearing on your request for variances has been scheduled for **Wednesday, October 19, 2016 at 5:30 p.m.**, Third Floor, City Council Chambers, at the Saint Paul City Hall/Ramsey County Courthouse, 15 Kellogg Boulevard W., Saint Paul, Minnesota.

You may wish to be present at this hearing to answer any questions that the City Council might have. After the public hearing, the Council may grant, deny, or modify the variance request.
