I would like you consider voting "no" to deny the appeal for 59 AHPC 15-7:

"Public hearing to consider the appeal of property owners, Saint Paul Housing and Redevelopment Authority (HRA), to a decision by the Heritage Preservation Commission denying the demolition of 716 Wilson Avenue in the Dayton's Bluff Heritage Preservation District."

This appeal is being initiated by City Staff whose personal interests are not aligned with the financial interests of the city. A 'yes' vote would mean forgoing the potential revenues of a sale with an open bidding process. I understand the push for quick approval is to act before Jane Prince, the newly elected council member for the Ward, takes the City Council seat.
