NOTICE OF INTENT TO SUSPEND LICENSES

Phalen Pounds, Owner Kenjoy's 705 – 3rd Street East St. Paul, MN 55106

Food Vehicle and Catering licenses held by Kenjoy's Catering, LLC d/b/a Kenjoy's for the City of Saint Paul License ID #20110004167

Dear Phalen Pounds:

The Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) has recommended suspension of the Food Vehicle and Catering licenses held by Kenjoy's Catering, LLC d/b/a Kenjoy's for the premises located at $705 - 3^{rd}$ Street East in Saint Paul. The basis for the recommendation is as follows:

On February 7, 2013, you were sent a letter and <u>RENEWAL INVOICE</u> from the Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) stating your Food Vehicle and Catering licenses expired as of October 9, 2012. You currently owe \$992.00 in delinquent license and late fees.

You were also asked to submit the following information along with the license fee payment:
1) current vehicle information (year, make model and license plate number) of vehicle transporting food and 2) a completed Certificate of Compliance Minnesota Workers' Compensation Law form.

You were given until February 28, 2013, to pay the license and late fees and submit the requested information. As of today's date, neither has been received.

In addition to the suspension of your Food Vehicle and Catering licenses, per Saint Paul Legislative Code §310.05 (m) (2), the licensing office will also recommend a \$500.00 matrix penalty for failure to submit the required information in order to maintain your license.

At this time, you have three options on how to proceed:

1. You can pay the delinquent license and late fees and submit the requested information. If this is your choice, you should send the payment and information directly to the Department of Safety and Inspections, at 375 Jackson Street, Ste. 220, St. Paul, Minnesota 55101-1806 no later than **Monday**, **April 1**, **2013**. A self-addressed envelope is enclosed for your convenience. Payment of the delinquent license and late fees and submission of the requested information will be considered to be a waiver of the hearing to which you are entitled.

- 2. If you wish to <u>admit</u> the facts but contest the penalty, you may have a public hearing before the Saint Paul City Council, you will need to send me a letter with a statement admitting the facts and requesting a public hearing. I will need to receive your letter by **Monday**, **April 1**, **2013**. The matter will then be scheduled before the City Council for a public hearing to determine whether to suspend your licenses and impose the \$500.00 matrix penalty. You will have an opportunity to appear before the Council and make a statement on your own behalf.
- 3. If you no longer wish to do business in the City of Saint Paul, you will need to send a written statement to that effect to the Department of Safety and Inspections, at 375 Jackson Street, Ste. 220, St. Paul, Minnesota 55101-1806 no later than **Monday**, **April 1, 2013**. Information should be directed to the attention of Christine Rozek.

If you have not contacted me by Monday, April 1, 2013, I will assume that you do not contest the suspension of your licenses and imposition of the \$500.00 matrix penalty. In that case, the matter will be placed on the City Council Consent Agenda for approval of the recommended penalty.
