9. Sound level requested: At or less than the "acceptable" decible rate St Paul requires.
10. Describe the noise source and all equipment involved: A microphone that's hooked up to a speaker system. We will keep the decible level lower than the "acceptable" level.
11. Describe the steps that will be taken to minimize the noise levels: For the start, there is not much sound & decible level will be very low. For the finish the sound is going "down" river, so Upper Landing residents will not hear much if any amplified sound.
12. State reason for seeking variance: (E.g. music, announcements, construction, etc.) Runners love to be recognized when finishing and our announcer congratulates and greets the participants. Runners deserve to be recognized by the announcer!

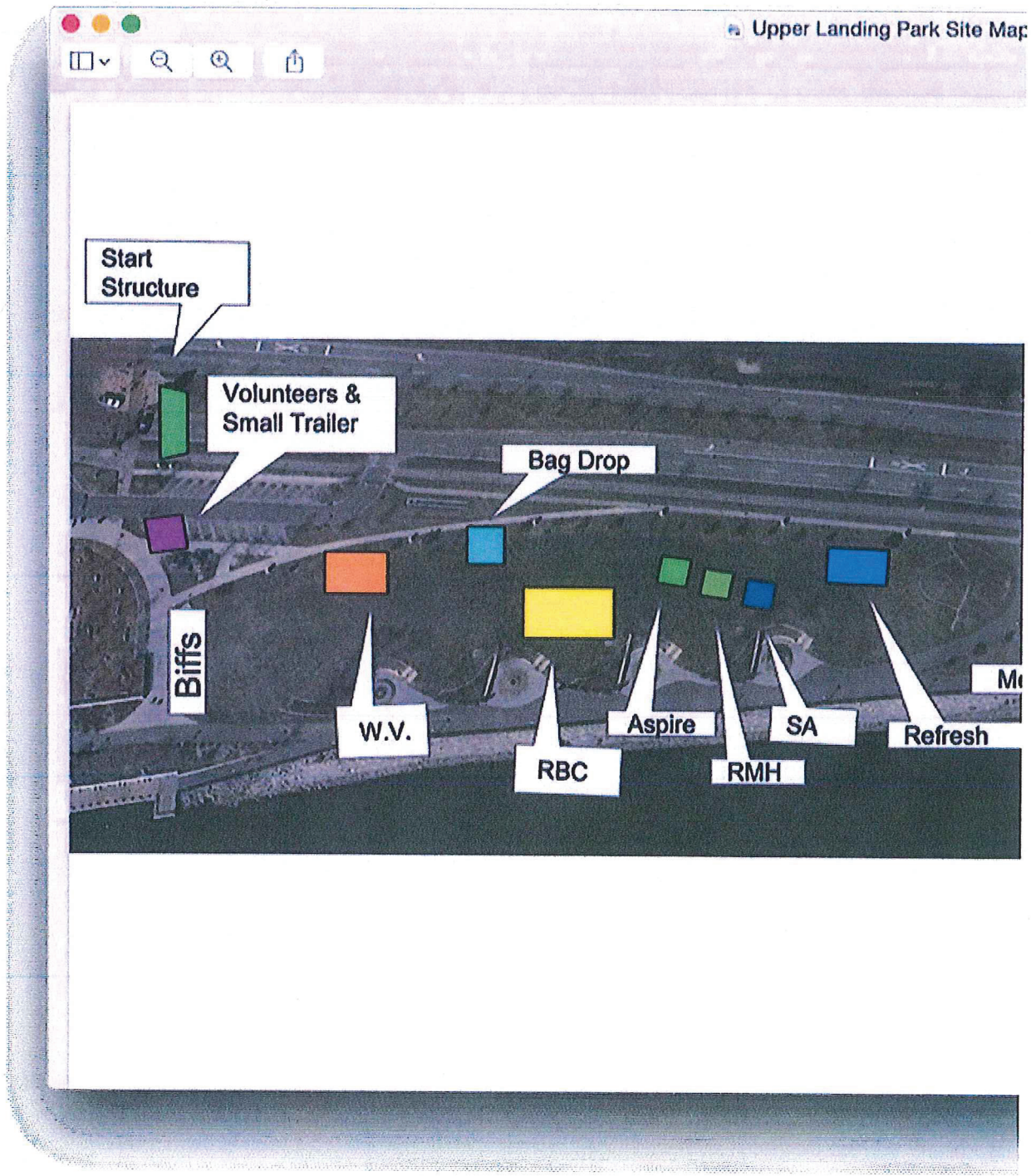

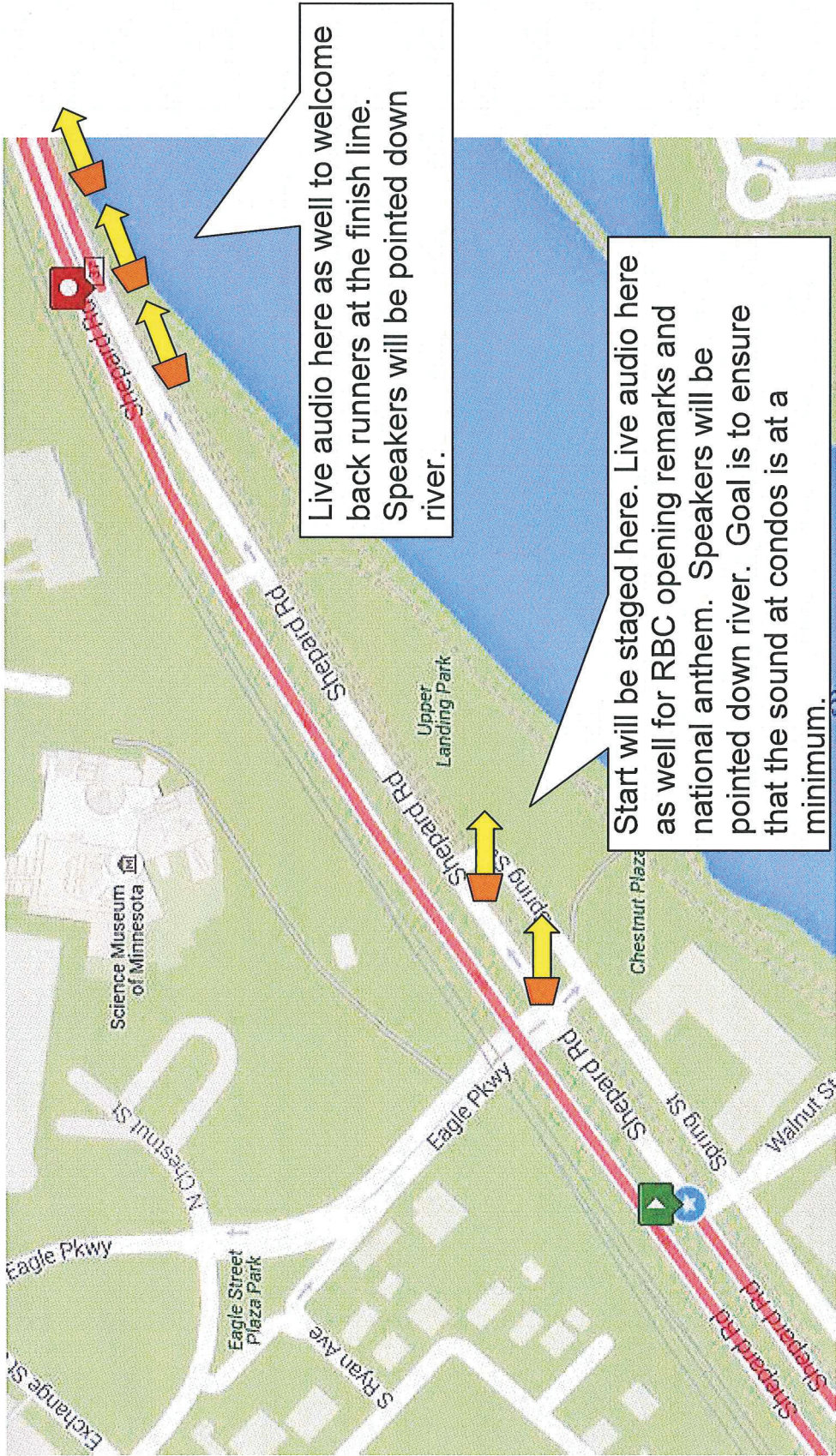
