

To whom it may concern:

Community Action Partnership of Ramsey and Washington Counties is submitting an Application for Appeal. Occupant received Fire Inspection Notice (Ref. #14703) where the organization is required to correct fire safety deficiencies.

BOTH STAIRWELLS - THROUGHOUT - MSFC 2015 [B] 1022.1 General.
 Interior exit stairways and interior exit ramps serving as an exit component in a means of egress system shall comply with the requirements of this section. Interior exit stairways and ramps shall lead directly to the exterior of the building or shall be extended to the exterior of the building with an exit passageway conforming to the requirements of Section 1023, except as permitted in Section 1027.1. An interior exit stairway or ramp shall not be used for any purpose other than as a means of egress.

-Remove/relocate the existing electrical equipment in the stairwells or provide a code compliant solution. All work must be done under permit and by a qualified contractor.

In Community Action's current state, all electrical equipment is clearly high enough and not impeding on existing egress. On average, all existing electrical is 8 to 10 ft. above the floor and secured appropriately. There are a minimal number (two) electrical components that are below 8 to 10 ft. height; it is important to note they are placed out of walkways and ramp areas, allowing for a 4 ft. open path. All stairwells have been clean and cleared of additional debris or obstructions, allowing pathways to stay clear and open for egress of occupants to exit free and easily.

The age of the building is approximately 90 years; the current state of equipment has also been in place for a number of years and previously has been found to be compliant with national electrical codes and building codes. A dramatic shift of equipment would place a large financial hardship on the local non-profit organization. The organization's mission is to reduce the causes of poverty and its impacts in the local community. It serves the community through Energy Assistance, Energy Conservation, Housing, Self-Sufficiency, Education, Transportation, and Head Start programs. Community Action has been a community partner serving St. Paul, Ramsey County, and Washington County since 1964.

On behalf of Community Action Partnership of Ramsey and Washington Counties, I appreciate your consideration and look forward to discussing further.

Your building was re-inspected for the Fire Certificate of Occupancy on October 24, 2018. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected immediately. A reinspection will be made on or after November 26, 2018.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

## **DEFICIENCY LIST**

- 1. BOTH STAIRWELLS THROUGHOUT MSFC 2015 [B] 1022.1 General. Interior exit stairways and interior exit ramps serving as an exit component in a means of egress system shall comply with the requirements of this section. Interior exit stairways and ramps shall lead directly to the exterior of the building or shall be extended to the exterior of the building with an exit passageway conforming to the requirements of Section 1023, except as permitted in Section 1027.1. An interior exit stairway or ramp shall not be used for any purpose other than as a means of egress.
  - -Remove/relocate the existing electrical equipment in the stairwells or provide a code compliant solution. All work must be done under permit and by a qualified contractor.
- 2. HEADSTART MAIN EXIT MSFC 1008.1.9.8-The access controlled egress system is missing a request to exit button. Provide a request to exit button, all work must be done by a qualified contractor.
