Shop with Cops started in 2000 as an initiative from the SPPD West District. The purpose of the event is to foster positive relationships between youth and officers. Young kids, K - 6th grade are selected each year during the end-of-the-year holiday season to shop at one of the local area stores to purchase gifts for members of their immediate family. Each child is given a small amount of money to spend, normally \$50-\$100 depending on the size of the child's immediate family. Approximately 1-2 children are assigned to each police officer, who then escorts them around the store and assists in selecting appropriate gifts for each family member. The children understand that the money is not for personal use and must only be spent on household members. After shopping, the children will eat lunch, wrap their gifts, and continue to get to know the police officers.

This program originally received Federal Funding which has been cut. Since that time, Shop with Cops has been solely funded through corporate and private funding sources. Target, Walmart and the SPPD Foundation are the major funders for this program. The fiscal agent is the District 8 Planning Council. This year's event will be held on December 10<sup>th</sup>.

In 2010, the Police Foundation granted this program \$4000.00 and we are requesting \$5000.00 this year to facilitate the high numbers of our local youth who participate in this program. To illustrate the success of this program we took a look at how many youth were served in recent years. In 2007, 82 children participated and this year we expect 250 children to participate. As you can see, the continued success relies on Foundation funds.

Thank you for your consideration with this request which has the potential to make for a very happy holiday season for many children in our community.

Cops and Kids has been in operation for approximately 10 years. The purpose of the Cops and Kids Program is to build positive relationships with the community and the police department. Again this year on December 15<sup>th</sup> the Cops and Kids committee, along with Santa, Mrs. Claus, Elves, Police Motors Officers, Police K-9 and several other officers will deliver presents to children in Children's Hospital and Gillette's Hospital. The Cops and Kids Committee raise money through fundraisers to purchase the gifts given to the children.
