This is to confirm that our office has received your application for a variance from the city's noise ordinance and that it is being processed.

The Department of Safety and Inspections has recommended that a variance be issued to allow you to provide amplified music at Rice Park, between 11:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. from January 26, 2012 through February 5, 2012, during the Saint Paul Winter Carnival. The recommendation is for a noise limit of 85 dBA as measured at any point on the public sidewalk surrounding the perimeter of Rice Park.

A public hearing on your request for a variance has been scheduled for **January 18, 2012, 5:30 p.m.**, Third Floor, City Council Chambers, at the Saint Paul City Hall/Ramsey County Courthouse, 15 Kellogg Boulevard W., Saint Paul, Minnesota.

You may wish to be present at this hearing to answer any questions that the City Council might have.
