Your building was inspected on November 21, 2011, for the renewal of the Certificate of Occupancy. Since you have failed to comply with the applicable requirements, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy in accordance with Section 33.05 of the Saint Paul Legislative Code. A inspection will be made on DECEMBER 12. 2011 AT 11:00A.M. TO VACATE YOUR BUIDLING.

The Saint Paul Legislative Code further provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. Failure to immediately complete the following deficiency list or the building vacated may result in a criminal citation.

DEFICIENCY LIST





Downstairs - MSFC 1011.2 - Remove the materials that cause an exit obstruction.

Maintain a clear and unobstructed exitway.-Remove COUCH FROM FRONT DOOR



Downstairs - SPLC 34.08 (7) - All parking spaces shall be paved with asphalt, concrete, or durable dustless surfacing. Before any existing spaces may be paved, site plan approval must be obtained as specified in the St. Paul Zoning Code. Contact DSI Zoning at 651-266-9090.



Downstairs - MN Rules 1300.0180 - Immediately discontinue use of unsafe heating appliance until repaired or replaced by a licensed contractor. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090. Furnace installed without permit



Downstairs - UMC 504.6 - Provide, repair or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth

interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter. This work will require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.

Downstairs - SPLC 34.11 (5), 34.34 (2) - Contact a licensed contractor to repair or replace the water heater. This work will require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090.-Hot water heater installed without a permit.

(6.) Unit Upstairs - SPLC 34.19 - Provide access to the inspector to all areas of the building.

downstairs - IFGC SECTION 303.3 PROHIBITED LOCATIONS; Appliances shall not be located in sleeping rooms bathrooms storage closets or surgical rooms.

MSFC- 603.6 - MASONRY CHIMNEYS - Masonry chimneys that upon inspection are found to be without a flue liner and that have open mortar joints which will permit smoke or gases to be discharged into the building or which are cracked as to dangerous shall be repaired.

SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) - Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office

SPLC 39.02(c) - Complete and sign the provided smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.

SPLC 34.08 (1), 34.31 (1) - All exterior property areas shall be maintained free from any accumulation of refuse, garbage or feces.
