Your building was re-inspected for the Fire Certificate of Occupancy on March 2, 2020. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected immediately. A reinspection will be made on April 29, 2020.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Bedroom N.W. side child room SPLC 34.13 OCUPANCY (3) Required space in sleeping rooms. in every dwelling unit every room occupied for sleeping purposes by one (1) occupant shall have a minimum gross flor area of at least seventy (70) square feet.-This room is 63 square feet.
- 2. SPLC 34.23, MSFC 110.1 This bedroom is condemned as unsafe or dangerous when being used for sleeping purposes. This bedroom must not be used for sleeping purposes until re-inspected and approved by this office.-
