## CORRECTION NOTICE

Dear Sir/Madam:

The City of Saint Paul, Department of Safety and Inspections has inspected the above referenced property on **January 10, 2025** and has determined that the following deficiencies exist in violation of the Saint Paul Legislative Code<sup>1</sup> (see footnote 1, below).

 SPLC 157.03. - PARKING: Stopping or parking prohibited in any of the following places: Across a curb, on a sidewalk or <u>boulevard</u>, lawn, or grass. Section (2) in front of or within five (5) feet, of the throat of any public or private driveway or alley, or in such a manner as to block such driveway or alley. Section (3) <u>On that portion of a</u> private road or <u>driveway lying between the public right of way line and the</u> <u>curb line of the adjacent street</u> or if no curb the edge of pavement. Section (20) On any street or alley, at the same location, for more than 48 consecutive hours.

THE DRIVEWAY APRON IS PART OF THE CITY RIGHT-OF-WAY/ BOULEVARD. PLEASE REMOVE THE BOAT AND TRAILER FROM THE CITY RIGHT-OF-WAY. THANK YOU. 2. SPLC 34.08. - **VEHICLES:** All vehicles must be correctly licensed, operable, secure from unauthorized entry, and parked on an improved surface. Correct violations, store in a garage or remove.

ALL VEHICLES/ TRAILERS ON THE PROPERTY MUST HAVE CURRENT TABS, MUST BE REGISTERED TO THE PROPERTY, MUST BE FULLY OPERATIONAL, **CANNOT BE MISSING ANY VITAL PARTS**, CANNOT BE OPEN TO ENTRY AND **MUST BE PARKED ON AN APPROVED SURFACE**. PLEASE BRING ALL VEHICLES INTO COMPLIANCE, STORE IN A GARAGE OR REMOVE NON-COMPLIANT VEHICLES FROM THE PROPERTY.

IF YOU INTEND TO PARK THE BOAT AND TRAILER ON YOUR PROPERTY, THE WHEELS AND TIRES MUST BE INSTALLED AND INTACT, AND THE BOAT AND TRAILER MUST BE PARKED ON A PAVED SURFACE. THANK YOU.

You are hereby notified to correct these deficiencies in accordance with the appropriate codes. The Enforcement Officer will re-inspect these premises on or after **February 07**, **2025**, by which date the violations noted must be corrected. Failure to correct these deficiencies may result in an abatement and/or additional fees for re-inspection.

You may file an appeal to this notice by contacting the City Clerk at 651-266-8585. Any appeal must be made in writing within 10 days of this notice. (You must submit a copy of this Notice when you appeal and pay a filing fee.)
