## NOTICE OF INTENT TO DENY LICENSE

Dear Mr. Lane:

The Department of Safety and Inspections will recommend denial of the Restaurant (2) 1-12 Seats license application submitted by Pizza Three LLC d/b/a Pizza 3 for the premises located at 1556 Selby Avenue in Saint Paul. The basis for the recommendation is based on the following information:

On March 1, 2013, you were sent a letter from the Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) stating they received information you no longer wish to pursue purchase the business at 1556 Selby Avenue in Saint Paul.

According to DSI records, your license application is still pending. You were given until March 8, 2013, to contact DSI regarding the status regarding this matter. As of today's date, you have not contacted DSI with the status of your license application or a request a withdraw your license application.

At this time, you have two options on how to proceed:

- 1. If you wish to admit the facts but you <u>contest</u> the penalty, you may have a public hearing before the Saint Paul City Council. You will need to send me a letter with a statement admitting to the facts and requesting a public hearing. I will need to receive your letter no later than **Monday**, **April 8**, **2013**. The matter will then be scheduled before the City Council for a public hearing to determine whether to deny your license. You will have an opportunity to appear before the Council and make a statement on your own behalf.
- You can withdraw your license application. Send a written statement to that effect to the Department of Safety and Inspections at 375 Jackson Street, Suite 220, St. Paul, Minnesota 55101-1806 no later than Monday, April 8, 2013. A self-addressed envelope is enclosed for your convenience. Any request for a refund of the license application fees must also be made in writing to the Department of Safety and Inspections.

If you have not contacted me or DSI by Monday, April 8, 2013, I will assume that you do not contest the denial of your license. In that case, the matter will be placed on the City Council Consent Agenda for approval of the recommended penalty.
