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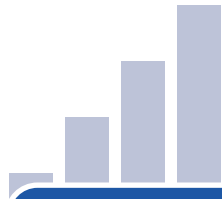
Implementation Plan Mission Statement

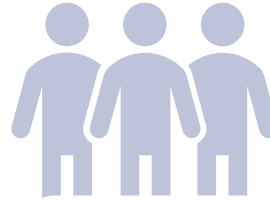

Implementation Goals

The ONS will focus on the following three goals so key results will position the ONS to be a long-term leader in CFPS:

Build the ONS Organization	Generate a Strategic Plan	Coordinate Operation PEACE
Hire three project coordinators	Gather feedback during district council town halls	Develop list of stakeholders for coordination
Recruit and select NSCC members, who generate its bylaws	Co-design strategic plan with NSCC and Optimal Response leaders	Decide on key neighborhoods for Operation PEACE programming
NSCC establishes working groups	Generate ONS mission, vision and guiding values	Identify key participants for programming

- Coordination with optimal response teams. Beginning stages of piloting coordinated response with SPPD and Ramsey County (Ongoing)
