This is an objection notice about adding a liquor-outdoor service area to Stone Saloon SBC.

There is already too many problems with the establishment, none the least of which, is the fact that most of the people who approved the establishment in the first place are NOT home owners in the area. They rent, but are not home owners. Licensing states the HOME OWNERS needed to approve.
