Dear Yaya Diatta, Zoning Administrator:

The Payne Phalen CPED Committee met on Wednesday, August 8th, 2012 and heard from the applicant Mr. Alan Young on the matter of two variances at 654 California East File # 12-071778. After deliberations, CPED voted to **recommend approval of both the deck variance and the driveway width variance**. The CPED Committee noted that the character of housing and alignment of yards and driveways has a more suburban feel and character in this northern section of District Five. The CPED Committee did not find the variance of the width of the driveway nor the variance related to the deck objectionable or limiting. CPED found that both variances largely fit in and did not detract from the character of the surrounding neighborhood.

The Board of Directors approved this position on the Consent Agenda at the August monthly meeting on August 28th, 2012.


