#### SUMMARY OF ENGINEERING RECOMMENDATION

#### Montreal Avenue New Sidewalk Construction

#### Ward 2

#### **PROJECT**:

This project is to complete the city sidewalk on the north side of **Montreal Avenue** between West Seventh Street and 35E Parkway. The new sidewalk is approximately 640' long and will be constructed in front of a total of six properties. This sidewalk construction to be done as part of the Madison/Benson RSVP Project.

#### **EXISTING CONDITIONS:**

This is an incomplete sidewalk. The existing sidewalk starts at West Seventh Street and stops near the end of the property of 1084 West Seventh Street. The area where the sidewalk is to be constructed is basically flat with some trees of various sizes.

## **INITIATING ACTION:**

This order was initiated by phone calls from local residences in the apartment complexes. They are asking for the sidewalk to be completed so they can get to West Seventh Street without having to walk in the street. Montreal Avenue is a truck route along this stretch.

### **ALTERNATES:**

Do nothing and this area will stay an incomplete walk where pedestrians will need to use the street.

### **POSITIVE BENFITS:**

The people who live on the north side of Montreal Avenue can get better walking access to West Seventh Street and Highland Park. With two large apartment buildings, this improvement will positively affect many.

#### ADVERSE EFFECTS

Normal problems associated with construction such as noise, dust, and general disruption to the neighborhood. There are direct assessments to the abutting properties and some of them may contest the project.

#### **EFFECTS ON TREES:**

There could be four to six trees needed to be removed for the new sidewalk.






