Dear City of St. Paul Legislative Staff,

Dear staff, please find enclosed our completed application for appeal: a check for the \$25.00 filing fee; copies of the two letters from the City and attachments; 2 emails to David Kueber; a photo of a guest resting on our bench taken last week; an email about the City boulevards and a photo of my father's bench.

Benches have a special place in our hearts. They are so welcoming and useful. My father's head stone is a bench, which is the only place in the cemetery for people to sit and rest. A copy of the photo is enclosed.

There was an elderly lady who walked by our house and she would rest on our front steps, which looked exceedingly uncomfortable. So, four years ago we purchased a bench with the purpose to have it on our boulevard for people to use as they walk, run by or want to rest. Our lawn has an incline, so a bench for guests is not feasible on the lawn.

Our goal was to welcome people and to copy other benches in the neighborhood, which we have rested on. There are many benches on the boulevards within a five block radius of our yard. Because the other benches were present, we believed ours would cause no hindrance. A friend and I even looked up what the City has posted on boulevard usage and the email is enclosed.

Originally, people believed the bench was free, and attempted to take it. So this year, we decided to plant a recycled fountain with flowers and place our bench next to it so people would understand it was not free for the taking. We also have displayed welcome signs, such as for the Fourth of July and to welcome guests of the Twin Cities Marathon.

In August, we received a Corrections Notice and I spoke with Officer Mark Kaiseratt and David Kuebler. Unaware that a permit was necessary, we attempted to attain one. The bench does not interfere with City plowing, nor does it infringe on the public walkway. At this time, we did not file an appeal since we thought we would be able to get a permit. Officer Kaisersatt called and asked for an update in September and I called him back and let him know I had spoken with David and had emailed him photos of the bench.


Officer Kaisersatt then called in October and I emailed David to ask for an update. This last Saturday, October 11th, we received a Summary Abatement Order.

Since I had not heard back from David, I called St. Paul City Permits and they said I needed to talk with Henry Ung in ordinance permits, who I then called and left a message yesterday. I have not heard back from David or Henry. At this point, I called our City Council Member Dave Thune and spoke with his legislative specialist, Pat. She said I could fill out an application for appeal, which I have done.

I am sorry that one person complained, but many people have thanked us, and expressed how they enjoy the bench, the welcome signs and the flower fountain.

I look forward to hearing from you and thank you for your consideration.

As owner or person(s) responsible for: 1126 SUMMIT AVE you are hereby ordered to eliminate all nuisance conditions which are in violation of Chapter 45 of Saint Paul Legislative Code.

- Remove improperly stored or accumulated refuse including: garbage, rubbish, discarded furniture, appliances, vehicle parts, scrap wood and metal, recycling materials, household items, building materials or rubble, tires, brush, etc., from yard areas.
- Cut and remove tall grass, weeds and rank plant growth.
- Remove and properly dispose of all animal feces from yard areas.
- IMMEDIATELY secure all buildings which are open to unauthorized entry, including:
- Other: REMOVE BENCH AND BIRD BATH FROM PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY (BLVD)

If you do not correct the nuisance or file an appeal before **October 15, 2014**, the City will correct the nuisance and charge all costs, including boarding costs, against the property as a special assessment to be collected in the same way as property taxes.

Charges: If the City corrects the nuisance, the charges will include the cost of correction, inspection, travel time, equipment, etc. The rate will be approximately \$260.00 per hour plus expenses for abatement.

You must maintain the premises in a clean condition and provide proper and adequate refuse storage at all times
FAILURE TO COMPLY MAY RESULT IN A CRIMINAL CITATION

If you have any questions about this order, the requirements or the deadline, you should contact the Inspector listed above, Monday through Friday.

Appeals: You may appeal this order and obtain a hearing before the City Council by completing an appeal application with the City Clerk before the appeal deadline noted above or seven (7) days after the date mailed, whichever comes first. No appeals may be filed after that date. You may obtain an appeal application from the City Clerk's Office, Room 310, City Hall, St. Paul, MN 55102. The telephone number is (651) 266-8585. You must submit a copy of this Correction Order with your appeal application.

***WARNING** Code inspection and enforcement trips cost the taxpayers money. If the violations are not corrected within the time period required in this notice, the city's costs in conducting a reinspection after the due date for compliance will be collected from the owner rather than being paid by the taxpayers of the city. If additional new violations are discovered within the next following 12 months, the city's costs in conducting additional inspections at this same location within such 12 months will be collected from the owner rather than being paid by the taxpayers of the city. Any such future costs will be collected by assessment against the real property and are in addition to any other fines or assessments which may be levied against you and your property.

The Enforcement Officer will reinspect these premises on or after **August 25, 2014**, by which date the violations noted must be corrected. **Failure to correct these deficiencies may result in the issuance of criminal charges²** and/or a civil lawsuit, and possible abatement/assessment by the City. All repairs and new installations must be made in accordance with the appropriate codes. Permits may be obtained by calling 651-266-8989.

You may file an appeal to this notice by contacting the City Clerk at 651-266-8585. Any appeal must be made in writing within 10 days of this notice. (You must submit a copy of this Notice when you appeal, and pay a filing fee.)
