

SUMMARY FOR LEGISLATIVE HEARING

300 Edmund Avenue

Legislative Hearing – **Tuesday, October 26, 2010**

City Council – **Wednesday, November 17, 2010**

The building is a two story, wood frame, duplex on a lot of 3,920 square feet.

According to our files, it has been a vacant building since October 7, 2009.

The current property owner is Sharrie Warner, per AMANDA and Ramsey County Property records.

There have been nine (9) SUMMARY ABATEMENT NOTICES since 2009.

There have been six (6) WORK ORDER(S) issued for:

- Removal of tall grass and weeds
- Removal of snow and ice
- Improperly stored refuse, garbage and misc debris

On July 28, 2010, an inspection of the building was conducted, a list of deficiencies which constitute a nuisance condition was developed and photographs were taken. An ORDER TO ABATE A NUISANCE BUILDING was posted on August 12, 2010 with a compliance date of September 20, 2010. As of this date this property remains in a condition which comprises a nuisance as defined by the legislative code.

The Vacant Building registration fees were paid. (*assessed on 1/8/10. 10/7/10-reassessed*)

Taxation has placed an estimated market value of \$14,400 on the land and \$41,500 on the building.

As of October 21, 2010, a Code Compliance Inspection has not been completed.

As of October 21, 2010, the \$5,000.00 performance bond has not been posted.

Real Estate taxes for the years 2009 and 2010 are delinquent in the amount of \$3,231.44, plus penalty and interest.

Code Enforcement Officers estimate the cost to repair this structure is \$60,000 to \$70,000. The estimated cost to Demolish is \$12,000 to \$15,000.

DSI, Division of Code Enforcement Resolution submitted for consideration orders the property owner to repair or remove this structure within fifteen (15) days, if not the resolution authorizes the Division of Code Enforcement to demolish and assess the costs to the property.
