This email is to confirm that today at the Legislative Hearing for your appealed tax assessment at 990 MARION STREET. (File No. J2124A, Assessment No. 218543) Ms. Moermond will recommend **this assessment be deleted if by October 4, 2021 you have:**

1. Installed motion detector lighting;
2. Put up no dumping and/or area under video surveillance signs; and
3. Cut back overgrown trees and brush from the area between garage and alley

An inspector will verify these items are completed on October 4. If they are not done, Ms. Moermond will recommend this assessment is **approved**. This matter will go before the City Council on October 6, 2021 at 3:30 pm. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, **we will not be holding hearings in person**.
