1-Sidewalk Cafe

Conditions:

- 1) FURNITURE/EQUIPMENT IS SUBJECT TO FIELD REVIEW & ADJUSTMENT BY DSI & ROW-
- 2) POSITION OF FURNITURE/EQUIPMENT MUST REMAIN IN FINAL ESTABLISHED LOCATION-
- 3) DEVIATION OF FURNITURE/EQUIPMENT IS NOT PERMITTED WITHOUT PRIOR APPROVAL-
- 4) INSPECTION MAY BE DONE TO CONFIRM FURNITURE/EQUIPMENT REMAIN STATIC-
- 5) VIOLATIONS CAN RESULT IN REVOCATION OF THE PERMIT

Permittee shall provide continuous, accessible and safe pedestrian walkway that meets ADA and MN MUTCD standards if working in sidewalk area. Contractor shall provide traffic control as per MN MUTCD requirements if working in the roadway area. Contractor should contact inspector to discuss and approve pedestrian and traffic control plan before starting work. No sidewalk cafe shall be permitted in any portion of the public sidewalk where normal pedestrian traffic flow is obstructed. A minimum clearance of forty eight inches must be maintained from all obstructions on the public sidewalk at all times. If at anytime, a Public Works inspector determines the sidewalk cafe has become a public hazard, the permit may be revoked. Refer to City Legislative Code Chapters 106, 116, and 135.

This card must be placed in view as directed by Right-of-Way Engineer.
 Violation of Chapter #135 of the City of Saint Paul Legislative Code is a misdemeanor.
