On 04/25/2014, at approximately 0945 hours, a patrol officer was dispatched to upper door 1 on a report of a fare dispute at a Taxi that had just arrived. I was nearby and responded to the location and located the taxi in question.

Officer Vu and Sgt. Hoerdt also arrived. Officer Vu spoke with the passengers. I spoke with the driver, identified by his MAC Taxi badge as Abageda Yahya.

Yahya said that he picked up 2 people at the Amtrack station in St. Paul to go to the airport. Since they were 2 separate passengers, Yahya said that he was going to charge them 2 separate fares, and Yahya stated that they all verbally agreed. Yahya has a very thick middle eastern accent, and I had a hard time understanding his english. Yahya kept raising his voice and shouting, I had to ask him lower his voice 2-3 times during our conversation.

After I was done speaking with Yahya, Officer Vu said the following about his conversation with the passengers:

- They did not agree to pay 2 separate fares.
- The 2 passengers were going to split the fare.
- The fare that was showing on the meter when they arrived at the airport was was \$25.
- The driver was asking for each person to individually to pay the full fare (no sign stating "fare per person" on the car)
- The driver was also charging for \$4 the airport access fee, on top of the meter fare (only applies if trip starts at the airport).

I also observed the following while speaking with the passengers and Yahya:

- One of the passenger appeared to be a special needs person.
- The driver kept the meter running the whole time after arriving at the airport.

- The driver was argumentative with officers.
- After the \$25 was paid, Yahya continued to argue about being able to double charge.
- I had to warn Yahya to arrest him if he did not immediately leave the area.

During report writing, it was discovered that the personal information that is on file with the badging office records, does not match the records for his drivers license. If the badge holder (Yahya) fails to update the badging records within 10 of changing his address, he is in violation of MAC ORD 117.3.7.

Yahya's drivers licenses was issued on 09/27/2013.

Steve Holes in MAC Landside requested a police report so he could contact the city of St. Paul to inform them of the incident.
