Your building was inspected on June 7, 2012 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date.

A re-inspection will be made on July 9, 2012 at 11:00 AM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. <u>Exterior SPLC 34.09 (2), 34.32(2)</u> Repair or replace the damaged boulevard handrail in an approved manner.
- 2. <u>Interior Basement MSFC 3404.2.13.2.3</u> All above/underground tanks which have been out of service at least 1 year shall be properly removed, unless tanks are tested in an approved manner and properly returned to service. This work may require permits. Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.

3. <u>SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3)</u> - Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
