CORRECTION NOTICE - RE-INSPECTION COMPLAINT

Dear Property Representative:

A re-inspection was made on your building on May 30, 2025 regarding the requirements from the Legislative Hearing Officer. You are hereby notified that the following deficiencies must be corrected prior to re-inspection date.

A reinspection will be made on July 10, 2025 at 10:30AM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

1. Unit 3 - SPLC 40.06(a)(3) Grounds for revocation. The fire code official may, in writing, issue a notice to the owner(s) and known interested parties of the city's suspension or revocation of a fire certificate of occupancy issued under the provisions of this code, or deny an application therefor: If it is found upon inspection of the fire code official that the building or occupancy is in violation of provisions of this or other applicable safety codes, ordinances, rules and regulations. Failure to comply with legislative hearing officer's orders. This is a partial revocation of the fire certificate of occupancy pertaining specifically to the third-floor unit with orders to vacate by July 10, 2025 if found noncompliant. If found non-compliant during the scheduled inspection, the third-floor unit is required to be vacated.

- 2. SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.33(2) Repair or replace the unsafe stairways, porch, decks or railings in an approved manner. Every outside stair, porch and deck shall be constructed safely and shall be capable of supporting imposed loads as determined in the building code and shall be kept in a professional state of maintenance and repair with proper anchorage. This work shall require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989. Northwestern most post is twisting out of place and is not properly secured to decking. Fasteners are beginning to deteriorate from rust. Per the Legislative Hearing Officer; the [repair for the] northwestern-most post of the deck... will be based on recommendation from your engineer's report that is to be submitted no later than April 28, 2025.
- 3. SPLC 34.09 (1)(2)(a), 34.33 (1)(b) Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint. Retaining wall on both Reaney Ave and White Bear Ave sides are significantly deteriorated. Immediately repair. This work shall require a permit. Contact DSI at (651) 266-8989 for more information.
- 4. SPLC 34.08 (10) Exterior sidewalks, walkways, and stairs. All sidewalks, walkways and exterior stairs shall be maintained in a professional state of maintenance and repair, free of defects and hazards. Provide adequate lighting to rear stairs.
