- No fines/fees for materials

### MAKER CAMPS

- Free, drop-in school and summer break enrichment programming
- Hands-on STEM activities

### PLAY SPACES

- Engages kids in creative play, essential for kindergarten preparation

### createtech

- Creative space just for teens
- Five spaces and programming in partnership with Parks, Science Museum of Minnesota, and SPNN
- Provides critical access to technology such as computers and iPads, photography, videography, and audio-recording equipment, Adobe Creative Suite, sewing machines, circuitry, and more

### SELF-DIRECTED PLAY

- Hands-on kids activities offered at peak hours
- Nurtures creativity and literacy
- Develops imagination

### ADVANCING LITERACY

### I READ! I VOTE!

- Kids read Minnesota Youth Reading Award books and vote for their favorite
- 3,035 kids participated in 2016
- Partners with schools to get books into school libraries

### READ BRAVE

- Supplies teens (grades 9-12) and adults with 700+ copies of a YA novel to spark intergenerational dialogue about teen issues

### SUPPORTING ACADEMIC SUCCESS

#### HOMework CENTERS

- 16,686 student visits in 2016
- Six sites that offer space, mentors, and supplies for youth and adult learners
- Live tutors available online for homework help in English/Spanish from 1-11 p.m. daily

#### RIGHT TRACK ENRICHMENT

- Teen cohorts meet weekly to gain job readiness and life skills
- Builds support and workplace community
