Description of Variance:

Location: Event will be located outdoors on Charles Avenue between Vandalia and Pillsbury Streets

Noise Source: Pro-Life Action Ministries has applied for a sound level variance in order to present a Good Friday Prayer Vigil Event with use of speakers on Charles Avenue between Vandalia and Pillsbury Streets, on Friday, April 14, 2017, from 8:00 a.m. to 4:15 p.m., with a sound check at 8:00 a.m., and at a requested sound level limit of 90 dBA at no specified distance. The Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) recommends the following conditions: 1) The variance will be for the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 4:15 p.m., with a sound check at 8:00 a.m. on April 14, 2017. 2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event must not exceed 85 dBA as measured 50 feet from sound source. 3) The applicant will provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices must be turned off no later than 4:15 p.m. on the date of the event.
