1 WHEREAS, the Department of Parks and Recreation has received an additional grant for the
2 development of the Cherokee Regional Park Trail project; and

4 WHEREAS, the preliminary trail plan concept was developed and approved by Parks and Recreation
5 working with the Cherokee Regional Park Design Advisory committee; and

7 WHEREAS, the approved grant funds are from the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources 2009
8 Parks and Trails Legacy Grant in the amount of \$250,000; and

10 WHEREAS, it is the desire of Saint Paul Parks and Recreation to amend the existing financing and
11 spending plan budget for the Cherokee Regional Trail project; and

13 WHEREAS, the Mayor, pursuant to Section 10.07.1 of the Charter of the City of Saint Paul, does certify
14 that there are available for the appropriation, funds of \$250,000 in excess of those estimated in the 2008
15 Capital Improvement Budget; and

17 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Saint Paul, upon
18 recommendation of the Mayor and the positive advice of the Long Range Capital Improvement Budget
19 Committee, that \$250,000 is available for the appropriation in the 2008 Capital Improvement Budget, and
20 said 2008 budget, as heretofore adopted by the Council, it here by further amended as follows:
