Description of Variance:

Locations for DC 15: Mississippi River Boulevard and Old Ford Plant Entrance; Shepard Road and Gannon Road

Noise Source: Team Ortho Foundation has requested sound level variances to provide the use of a sound system for announcements and amplified outdoor music for the Monster Dash Event. The variances are requested for various times between the hours of 8:00 a.m. until 1:30 p.m., with pre-event sound checks between 7:45 a.m. and 8:45 a.m. in District Council 15 at Mississippi River Boulevard and Old Ford Plant Entrance; Shepard Road and Gannon Road on Saturday, October 28, 2017. The Department of Safety and Inspections will be recommending the following conditions: 1) The Variances shall be for various times between the hours of 8:00 a.m. until 1:30 p.m., with pre-event sound checks between 7:45 a.m. and 8:45 a.m. at the following District Council 15 locations: Mississippi River Boulevard (MRB) and Old Ford Plant Entrance; Shepard Road and Gannon Road on Saturday, October 28, 2017. 2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 85 dBA as measured 50 feet at the MRB and Old Ford Plant Entrance site, and shall not exceed 80 dBA as measured 50 feet from any sound source at the Shepard Road and Gannon Road site, used for music and/or announcements. 3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 1:30 p.m. on the date of the event.

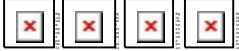
