Dear Property Representative:

Your building was re-inspected for the Fire Certificate of Occupancy on February 4, 2011. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected immediately.

A re-inspection will be made on March 8, 2011 at 1:00pm.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional re-inspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Basement Bathroom SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.33 (6) Repair and maintain the ceiling in an approved manner.
- 2. Basement Dryer Vent UMC 504.6 Provide, repair or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter. This work requires a permit. Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.- Remove the aluminum flexible exhaust duct and replace with the approved type. Aluminum flexible duct is only acceptable for transition usage.

3. Egress Windows - Main Floor and Basement Bedrooms - MSFC1026.1 - Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651) - 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more information.

Main Floor Northeast, Southeast, and Southwest Bedrooms (Double-hung)

15.5h x 37w - Openable 32h x 34w - Glazed

- 4. Garage Roof SPLC 34.09 (1) e, 34.32 (1) d Provide and maintained the roof weather tight and free from defects.-Repair/replace the roof that is leaking and causing the water damage to the interior ceiling of the garage.
- 5. Garage SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.33 (6) Repair and maintain the walls and ceiling in an approved manner.-Repair/replace the damaged walls and ceiling in the garage.
- 6. Main Floor Southwest Bedroom MSFC 605.6 Provide electrical cover plates to all outlets, switches and junction boxes where missing.-Replace the missing electrical cover plate on the light switch.
- 7. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 8. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the provided smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
