Hi St. Paul City Council,

Please note that I am Kyle Olson property owner of Parcel ID # 16-28-23-42-0012 and I object to the proposed 2023 Mill and Overlay - Fairview Avenue: Randolph to Edgcumbe project.

Although I believe this should be done, I don't not think that this cost should be levied onto myself or the other individual home owners upon this stretch of Fairview due to the fact that this road is a major thoroughfare for all of Highland Park commuters and leads directly to MN HWY 5 and the airport. Due to the high volume of traffic that this road receives from people not included in the billing and the poor level of upkeep done by the city over the last two years I have lived here (especially last winter when they basically destroyed the road by plowing) in no way do i believe it is my responsibility to take the brunt of these repair costs. I feel that my already extremely high property taxes, along with state income tax I pay and the 16 billion dollar surplus the state has should be more than adequate to cover these costs.

Furthermore this is an extremely high cost to expect a homeowner to pay to repair a one of busiest roads in Highland Park and the surrounding areas of St. Paul. With a family of 4 living off of one income this bill would cripple me for a long period of time and limit my ability to pay for my day to day expenses.

Basis my explanation above i once again object to having to pay for any part of the 2023 Mill And Overlay - Fairview Avenue: Randolph to Edgcumbe.
