NOTICE OF INTENT TO SUSPEND LICENSE

Dear Ms. MacDonald:

The Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) has recommended suspension of the Massage Practitioner license held by Patricia F. MacDonald d/b/a Patricia F. MacDonald for the premises located at 1415 Almond Avenue in Saint Paul. The basis for the recommendation is as follows:

On November 17, 2010, you were sent a <u>SECOND REQUEST</u> letter from the Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) requesting that you submit the following information: 1) current certificates of General and Professional Liability for the coverage period of June 25, 2010 through June 25, 2011 with a 30 day notice of cancellation and naming the City of Saint Paul as additional insured and 2) Proof of Affiliation from Ruthann Ryberg, Massage Center license holder.

You were given until December 1, 2010, to submit the requested information. As of today's date neither has been received.

In addition to the suspension of your Massage Practitioner license, per Saint Paul Legislative Code §310.05 (m) (2), the licensing office will also recommend a \$500.00 matrix penalty for failure to submit required information in order to maintain your license.

At this time, you have three options on how to proceed:

1. You can submit the required insurance information and Proof of Affiliation. If this is your choice, you can send the information to the Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) located at 375 Jackson Street, Ste. 220, St. Paul, Minnesota 55101-1806 no later than **Monday, December 20, 2010.** A self-addressed envelope is enclosed for your convenience. Submission of the required information will be considered a waiver of the hearing to which you are entitled.

- 2. If you wish to admit the facts but you <u>contest</u> the license suspension and \$500.00 matrix penalty, you may have a public hearing before the Saint Paul City Council. You will need to send me a letter with a statement admitting to the facts and requesting a public hearing. I will need to receive your letter by **Monday, December 20, 2010.** The matter will then be scheduled before the City Council for a public hearing to determine whether to impose the license suspension and \$500.00 matrix penalty. You will have an opportunity to appear before the Council and make a statement on your own behalf.
- 3. If you <u>dispute the facts</u> outlined above, you may request a hearing before an Administrative Law Judge (ALJ). At that hearing both you and the City will appear and present witnesses, evidence and cross-examine each other's witnesses. After receipt of the ALJ's report (usually within 30 days), a public hearing will need to be scheduled. At that time, the City Council will decide whether to adopt, modify or reject the ALJ's report and recommendation. If this is your choice, please advise me no later than **Monday**, **December 20**, **2010**, and I will take the necessary steps to schedule the administrative hearing.

If you have not contacted me by that date, I will assume that you do not contest the suspension of your license and imposition of the \$500.00 matrix penalty. In that case, the matter will be placed on the City Council Consent Agenda for approval of the recommended penalty.
