Noise Source: The ALS Association Minnesota North Dakota South Dakota Chapter, Twin Cities Walk to Defeat ALS 2016 Event, represented by Jessica Jesswein, Corporate Relations Manager, has requested a sound level variance in order to present a D.J. and announcements at Lake Phalen Park from 8:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m., with a pre-event sound check at 8:00 a.m. on Saturday, September 17, 2016. The Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) recommends the following conditions: 1. The variance shall be for the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. on Saturday, September 17, 2016. 2. All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 85 dBA as measured at 50 feet from the sound source. 3. The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment to monitor sound level limits as specified in Condition #2. 4. All electronically powered sound equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 12:00 p.m. on the event date.
