Re: Appeals of Egress Windows (March 6, 2012 Legislative Hearing)

Dear Mr. Swanson:

This is to confirm that Marcia Moermond, Legislative Hearing Officer, has reviewed the above-referenced matters and recommended the following to the City Council:

1664 Chambers Street - grant a 3-inch variance on the openable height of the egress window in the southeast bedroom;

1222 Desoto Street - grant a 1-inch variance on the openable width of the egress windows in the southeast and northeast bedrooms;

842 Geranium Avenue East - grant a 2-inch variance on the openable height of the egress window in the north bedroom;

789 Hyacinth Avenue East - grant a 5-inch variance on the openable height of the egress windows in the north and south bedrooms;

876 Sherwood Avenue - grant a 4.5-inch variance on the openable height of the egress window in the 2nd floor bedroom; and

1676 Westminster Street - grant a 1-inch variance on the openable height of the egress window in the first floor, northeast bedroom and grant a 6-inch variance on the openable height of the egress window in the 2nd floor bedroom.

The City Council Public Hearing is scheduled for Wednesday, April 4, 2012 at 5:30 p.m. in Rooms 40A & B; however, you don't need to attend since the appeal has been granted.
