NOTICE OF INTENT TO DENY LICENSE

Taxicab Driver (Provisional) license application submitted by Abdikadir M. Muse d/b/a Abdikadir M. Muse for the City of Saint Paul License ID #: 20110002663

Dear Abdikadir M. Muse:

The Department of Safety and Inspections will recommend denial of the Taxicab Driver (Provisional) license application submitted by Abdikadir M. Muse d/b/a Abdikadir M. Muse for the City of Saint Paul. The basis for the recommendation is based on the following information:

On August 3, 2011, you told the Department of Safety and Inspections that you previously held a driver's license in State of Texas from 2002 to 2003 and a State of Illinois driver's license from 2004 to 2011. You were then informed by DSI, that you must provide them with certified copies for their review. As of today's date DSI has not received your State of Illinois and State of Texas driving records.

Saint Paul Legislative Code § 376.16 (e) (5) (e) states "An applicant who has had a driver's license outside the State of Minnesota at any time during the ten (10) years prior to application shall submit a copy of that applicant's driving record from that state."

At this time, you have three options on how to proceed:

- 1. You can submit copies of your State of Illinois and State of Texas driving records. If this is your choice, you should send the information directly to the Department of Safety and Inspections, at 375 Jackson Street, Ste. 220, St. Paul, Minnesota 55101-1806 no later than Friday, May 18, 2012. Information should be directed to the attention of Christine Rozek. A self-addressed envelope is enclosed for your convenience. Submission of the requested information will be considered to be a waiver of the hearing to which you are entitled.
- 2. If you wish to admit the facts but you contest the penalty, you may have a public hearing before the Saint Paul City Council. You will need to send me a letter with a statement admitting to the facts and requesting a public hearing. I will need to receive your letter no later than Friday, May 18, 2012. The matter will then be scheduled before the City Council for a public hearing to determine whether to deny your Taxicab Driver (Provisional) license. You will have an opportunity to appear before the Council and make a statement on your own behalf.

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3. You may withdraw your license application. Send a written statement to that effect to the Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI), 375 Jackson Street, Ste. 220, St. Paul, Minnesota 55101-1806 no later than Friday, May 18, 2012. Information should be directed to the attention of Christine Rozek. Any request for a refund of the license application fee must also be made in writing to the Department of Safety and Inspections.

If you have not contacted me by Friday, May 18, 2012, I will assume that you do not contest the denial of your Taxicab Driver (Provisional) license. In that case, the matter will be placed on the City Council Consent Agenda for approval of the recommended penalty.
