Your building was inspected on February 17, 2011 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date.

A re-inspection will be made on March 22, 2011 at 11:00 am.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. EXTERIOR MSFC 1010.5, SPLC 34.14 (2) d, SPLC 34.34 (5) b Provide and maintain illumination in all portions of the exit system.-Replace light above front door.
- 2. INTERIOR MSFC 605.4 Discontinue use of all multi-plug adapters.
- 3. INTERIOR MSFC 605.5 Discontinue use of extension cords used in lieu of permanent wiring.

- 4. INTERIOR MSFC1026.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651)-266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupanices handout for more information.-Immediately remove all bedroom materials from basement and discontinue use as a sleeping room, or provide an approved escape window. Upon inspection, double-hung window in upstairs bedroom measured 19.5 inches openable height x 27 inches openable width.
- 5. INTERIOR SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.33 (6) Repair and maintain the ceiling in an approved manner.-Properly remove mold-like substance from ceiling above bathtub. Repair water-damaged ceiling in south downstairs bedroom. All work must be done in a professional manner.
- 6. INTERIOR SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.33 (6) Repair and maintain the walls in an approved manner.-Replace missing wall tiles above bathtub in a professional manner.
- 7. INTERIOR MN State Statute 299F.50 Immediately provide and maintain an approved Carbon Monoxide Alarm in a location within ten (10) feet of each sleeping area. Installation shall be in accordance with manufacturers instructions.-Provide Carbon Monoxide detector for upstairs bedroom within 24 hours.
- 8. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
