Hi James,

My family and I live at 1514 Laurel, next door to the vacant house and garage at 1510. We are in support of the plan to demolish it. We believe the space at this address is better and safer as an empty lot, and we hope the committee and city proceed with the plans to bring it down.

The owner has not done anything meaningful with the property in more than five years (far longer than it has been declared vacant), and shows no signs of being able to meet the requirements necessary to rehab the property. I believe the structures will only continue to deteriorate further, detracting from the value of our property and punishing all the neighbors and our first responder resources by attracting criminality.

The house is very rundown and has attracted unwanted attention. During the time it has been empty (since 2020) there have been several break-ins that have endangered us and our small child. The police have been called to the address many times. There was a break-in through the back door, and the owner asked the police to go in and inspect. The police refused to enter because so much trash was piled up. The porch is also completely full of junk.

The yard is frequently overgrown and neglected, and I've photographed squirrels inside the house. Shingles are falling regularly from the roof. There are holes in the garage roof and in the walls.
