Noise Source: India Association of Minnesota has applied for a sound level variance, at a requested sound level limit of 92 dBA at no specified distance to provide amplified sound on the State Capitol Front Steps for the India Fest Event. The variance is requested for the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. on Saturday, August 19, 2017. The Department of Safety and Inspections will be recommending the following conditions: 1) The variance shall be for the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. for the Event on Saturday, August 19, 2017. 2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 85 dBA as measured 50 feet from any sound source used for music and/or announcements. 3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 10:00 p.m. on the date of the event.
