WHEREAS, Ord 20-36, an emergency ordinance to permit services on a temporary basis at 296 7th Street West (“Freedom House”) to people experiencing homelessness, was adopted by the Mayor and Council of the City of Saint Paul in November 2020; and

WHEREAS, prior to adopting Ord 20-36 in November 2020, the Mayor and City Council did not receive a recommendation from the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, in order to satisfy a March 2022 order from Ramsey County District Court and Minn. Statutes 462.357, the Planning Commission must provide its recommendation on Ord 20-36; and

WHEREAS, a duly noticed public hearing will be held on the matter at the Saint Paul City Council in order to meet the requirements of the Ramsey County District Court order and Minn. Statutes 462.357; and

WHEREAS, the Comprehensive and Neighborhood Planning Committee of the Saint Paul Planning Commission, having reviewed a memorandum containing analysis provided by staff, provided a recommendation for consideration by the Saint Paul Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Saint Paul Planning Commission, having reviewed the Comprehensive and Neighborhood Planning Committee’s recommendation, finds Ord 20-36 to be supported by the policies of the Comprehensive Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Saint Paul Planning Commission, under the authority of the City’s Legislative Code, that Ord 20-36 is recommended for approval by the Mayor and Council of the City of Saint Paul.
