



Bed Bug Service Preparation Check List

Bed bugs are difficult to deal with and require the combined efforts of the tenant and/or property owner and qualified pest control technician. A combination of preparation prior to treatment, chemical treatment is recommended to effectively control bed bugs. Failure to properly prepare your unit(s) will often result in less than desired results.

- 1) Everything that can be laundered, **MUST** be laundered in hot water and dried with hot air, then placed in airtight sealed bags/containers.
- 2) Vacuum the entire dwelling thoroughly. Discard vacuum bag upon completion
- 3) Remove all belongings from furniture, tables, wardrobes, and closets. Store in airtight bags/containers.
- 4) All luggage bags must be completely empty and left in dwelling.
- 5) Shoes must be individually bagged in airtight bags/containers.
- 6) Some infestation requires that furniture; personal belongings, mattresses, and/or miscellaneous items may have to be discarded. This will be decided at time of service(s) and inspection(s) by the technician(s).
- 7) Remove all posters and picture frames from walls.
- 8) Remove, discard, or store all cardboard in airtight bags/containers.
- 9) Remove all wall electrical outlet/switch covers from all rooms.
- 10) Remove all clutter/inventory from the inside and outside of: nightstands, dressers, china hutches, display cases, shelves, bookshelves, entertainment centers, and etc.
- 11) Any personal items that cannot be washed, dried, or treated must stored in an airtight bag/container for 18 months or more.
- 12) Be prepared to not reenter dwelling for 4 or more hours until dwelling is dry.
- 13) Do not allow clutter to accumulate after treatment.
- 14) After treatment and upon reentering dwelling, all mattresses and box springs **must** be placed in Bed Bug proof zippered encasements immediately.
- 15) Note: Please do not exceed 25 lbs. per bag/container. This will allow BE THERE to move the inventory around while servicing the dwelling.

Careful inspection and documentation 3-5 weeks after initial service will help BE THERE technician(s) determine the number of additional visits needed.
