Your building was re-inspected for the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected immediately. A reinspection will be made on or after September 15, 2011.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Exterior North Stairway to 2nd Floor SPLC 34.09 (2), 34.32(2) Repair or replace the unsafe stairways, porch, decks or railings in an approved manner. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090. Repair improperly supported landing on exterior stairway.
- 2. Garage SPLC 34.08 (5), 34.31 (3) Repair, replace and maintain all exterior surfaces on fences, sheds, garages and other accessory structures free from holes and deterioration. Provide and maintain exterior unprotected surfaces painted or protected from the elements.-Repair and tuckpoint brick as necessary. Repair and seal soffit, fascia and other exterior surfaces in a professional manner. Repair and seal garage door.

This repair will require a building permit, call DSI at (651) 266-9090.

3. Garage - SPLC 34.10 (2), 34.33 - Repair and maintain the damaged structural member. This repair will require a building permit, call DSI at (651) 266-9090. - Repair structurally unsound and leaning garage wall. Brick wall has cracked and shift significantly.
