PIG'S EYE SITE

We continue to use this site, and to work with St. Paul Parks and Recreation to obtain a larger site for long-term use.



CAMERA INSTALLATION

We are installing two cameras on the site to monitor the site entrance and recycling area. The cameras will be mounted on a wooden pole on the northeast corner of the site. The pole is up and the fiber-optic cables along the southern side of the site have been installed. We will be mounting the cameras and pulling the cable to complete the project.

HYDRO-SEEDING

We have completed the hydro-seeding (May 31). The grass is taking root in those areas and appears to be healthy.



MATERIAL RE-USE

We continue to haul material to a company for re-use, which further reduces the number of trips to Sandy Lake.



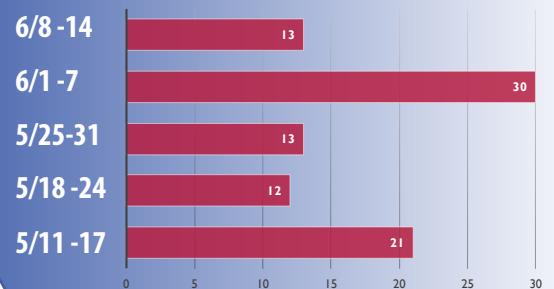
HAULING
