This is to confirm that at the Legislative Hearing on January 11, 2022, Assistant Legislative Hearing Officer Nhia Vang recommended that the City Council deny your appeal of the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy and grant an extension allowing continuing occupancy if the following conditions are met: 1) February 1, 2022 for compliance with items 8-12, 13, 14, and 16-18 and 2) June 7, 2022 for balance of the orders.
