SPRWSVA 2021-06: Engineering 10/25/2021 1:10 P.M.: Engineering DPU driver was traveling EB on Grand at Chatsworth in Van #501 and was rear-ended by vehicle #2 (truck) just after stopping for a pedestrian in the crosswalk. The SPRWs driver filed an injury report due to whiplash symptoms. The van was sent to the body shop for rear-end damage and repairs are the responsibility of the insurance company for vehicle #2.

SPRWSVA 2021-07: Distribution 10/26/2021 1:55 P.M.: Distribution asphalt restoration crew driver was stopped in the parking lot of a Holiday station at Plato & Wabash waiting for a parking space to open-up. A short time later a driver in vehicle #2 behind him began backing out of a parking space and struck the rear of the SPRWs truck with the left rear of their vehicle, causing damage to that area of #2. There were no injuries to either driver. And there was no damage to the SPRWS vehicle. No damage claim should come to SPRWS as a result of this accident.

SPRWSVA 2021-08 Business Meter Operations 12/21/2021: Meter Technician driving Transit Van #535 was NB on Woodbridge Street nearing Larpenteur was slowing to stop when Vehicle #2 (Pontiac G6) driving WB on Larpenteur, turned SB onto Woodbridge and began to slide and was unable to stop and bumped into the front end of #535 with the front end of #2. There were no injuries. #535 had minor bumper damage (no repair necessary) while # 2 had front bumper and grill damage, which the driver said was damaged prior to the accident.
