

Re: Non-compliant garage at 340 Summit Avenue (HPC File #09-016. Building Permit # 2009 071075)

Dear Mr. Anderson:

A recent inspection of the referenced structure reveals it to be non-compliant with the approved plans as well as the conditions placed upon its construction by the Heritage Preservation Commission (HPC).

The HPC conditions required that "All final materials, details and colors shall be reviewed and approved by HPC staff or the HPC." Further the HPC decision letter states that "A final materials mock-up panel shall be constructed and located on site. Staff will be notified when it is available and a few HPC members shall review the mock-up panel. Final materials and colors will be verified and approved."

These requirements were not met and the resulting construction does not comply.

Specifically, the cast stone veneer and mortar does not match the existing house as required by the approved plan, the stucco board panels above the cast stone cladding do not match the trim details of the approved plan, rain barrels have not been provided at the rear of the structure, and the large paved area immediately north of the structure was not approved for installation.

In addition to the failure to provide a mock-up for approval, there were no calls for inspection of the structure after the approval of the foundation. This may mean that construction details will have to be exposed to satisfy the Minnesota State Building Code's inspection requirements.

To achieve compliance with the HPC and building code requirements and the approved plans you are ordered to:

- 1. Remove the cast stone claddings as well as the areas of stucco above.
- 2. Remove the area of paving to the north of the structure in accordance with the approved site plan.
- 3. Provide rain barrels in the locations identified in the approved plan.
- 4. Provide a materials mock-up panel for review and approval by the HPC as detailed in the HPC decision letter dated June 2, 2009. Re-construct accordingly.
- 5. Obtain building inspection of the structure.

These orders must be complied with before August 16, 2010. Appeals of these orders must be filed before July 9, 2010.
