### Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on October 15, 2010 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date. A reinspection will be made on November 16, 2010 at 11:00 A.M..

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

#### DEFICIENCY LIST

1. All bedrooms - MSFC1026.1 - Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651)- 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more information.-Measured at 19inches openable height 31inches openable width sill 36inches Glazed 38inches height by 28inches width.

- 2. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 3. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the provided smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
- 4. SPLC 34.09 (1) b,c, 34.32 (1) b,c Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint.
- 5. SPLC 34.09 (2), 34.32(2) Repair all loose guardrail in an approved manner.
- 6. SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Provide or repair and maintain the window screen.
- 7. SPLC 34.10 (4), 34.33 (3) Provide a bathroom floor impervious to water. caulk the base of the toilet
- 8. MSFC 605.1- All light fixtures shall be maintained with protective globes if originally equipped.
