


Outside Recognition and Support

- Tree-planting on private property




Greenhouse Gas Emissions in Saint Paul

Energy Burden

- Electrically-heated homes pilot with Xcel, CEE
- Healthy Homes Saint Paul low-income preweatherization
- Increased Federal Weatherization \$ in IIJA
- Xcel's approved IRP increases efficiency programs
- To meet goals, additional \$ sources will be needed

- EV Spot Network/EV Carshare
- Advocating new MNDOT Vehicle Miles Traveled reduction g
- Joint bikeshare/scooter-share RFP with Minneapolis in 2021
- Rethinking I-94 transit first, Rondo vision, reduce VMT




