Re: Remove or Repair of the Structure at <u>939 Charles Avenue</u>

Dear Ms. Miller & Mr. Frey:

This is to confirm that at the City Council Public Hearing on January 26, 2022 the City Council continued the matter to Public Hearing on February 9, 2022 at 3:30 p.m.

A \$5,000 performance deposit must be posted with the Department of Safety & Inspections by close of business by February 4, 2022 in order to be referred back to Legislative Hearing on March 8, 2022 via phone between 10:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. for further discussion.

If the performance deposit is not posted, at the City Council Public Hearing on February 9 Ms. Moermond will recommend the Council order the building removed within 15 days with no option to repair.

If the performance deposit is posted and matter is referred back to Legislative Hearing March 8, the following items must be submitted no later than close of business March 4, 2022:

- 1. submit work plan, sworn construction statement, or scope of work that addresses all items in the Code Compliance Inspection report. This should include **signed** subcontractor bids and a schedule for completion of the project;
- 2. submit evidence of financing sufficient to complete the rehabilitation. Staff estimates cost \$100,000. If total for bids are more than 20% less than staff estimate, a high level of detail will be required. Financing could be business or personal accounts, a line of credit, or construction loan. Other types of financing will be reviewed on a case by case basis; and
- 3. Submit an affidavit indicating the finances will be dedicated to completing the project and not diverted until a code compliance certificate is issued.



**As always the property must continue to be maintained.** The performance deposit form can be found online here: <a href="https://www.stpaul.gov/departments/safety-inspections/vacant-buildings">https://www.stpaul.gov/departments/safety-inspections/vacant-buildings</a>. A copy was also sent with your previous letter. Please contact the Department of Safety and Inspections directly at 651-266-8989 for questions regarding the application or payment process.

This matter will again go before the City Council on Wednesday, February 9, 2022 at 3:30 p.m. in room 300 City Hall. If you are contesting Ms. Moermond's recommendation, you may appear in person or send written testimony to be added to the record to <a href="mailto:legislativehearings@ci.stpaul.mn.us">legislativehearings@ci.stpaul.mn.us</a> or by voicemail at 651-266-6805.
