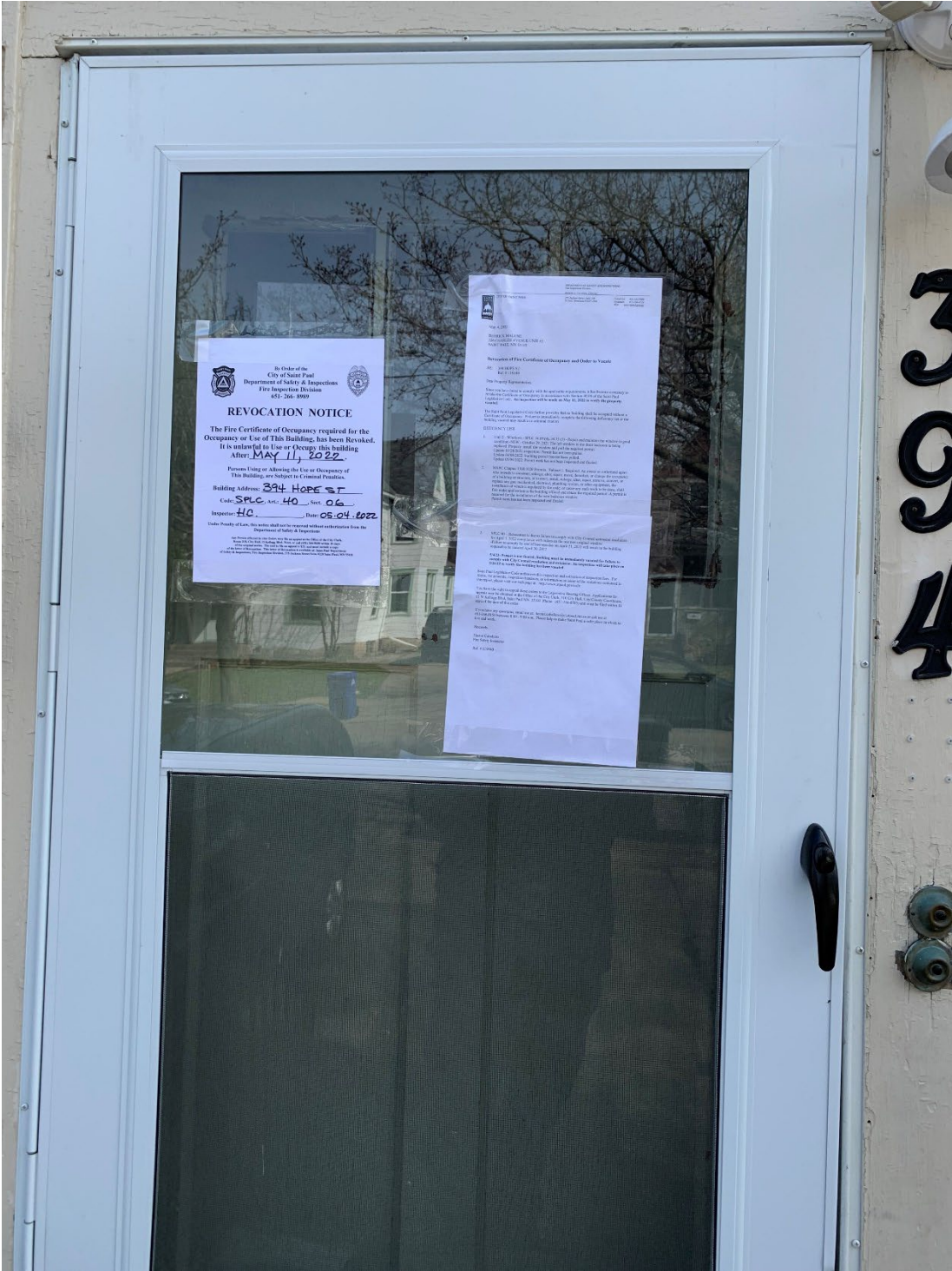

Notice of Fire Certificate of Occupancy and Order to Vacate

Dear Sir/Madam:

On May 11, 2022, the Fire Inspectors Division of the Department of Safety & Inspections, City of Saint Paul, Minnesota, issued a Notice of Fire Certificate of Occupancy and Order to Vacate for the property located at 394 Hope St, Saint Paul, MN 55103. The property is currently occupied by [redacted].

The Fire Certificate of Occupancy (FCO) is a document that certifies that a building meets the minimum fire and life safety requirements for its intended use. It is required for all buildings that are occupied by people.

The FCO for the property at 394 Hope St was issued on [redacted] and is valid until [redacted]. However, the FCO was revoked on May 11, 2022, due to the following reasons:

- 1. The building does not meet the minimum fire and life safety requirements for its intended use.
- 2. The building is currently occupied by people.
- 3. The building is in violation of the Fire Code, Article 40, Section 06.
